



Certification of DFARS Compliance Carr Lane Manufacturing Co.

The Berry Amendment, United States Code Title 10 Section 2533a, requires the United States Department of Defense to purchase certain items, including those made from "specialty metals" such as stainless steel, exclusively from American sources. The follow-up regulations, Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) Clause 252.225-7008, *Restriction on Acquisition of Specialty Metals*, prohibit prime government contractors and their suppliers at every tier from incorporating "specialty metals" (as defined in the clause) into military parts, components, and/or end-item deliverables, unless the specialty metals have been melted in the United States or other qualifying country listed in DFARS 225.225-7002 (currently Australia, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Czech Republic, Denmark, Egypt, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Israel, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, United Kingdom of Great Britain, and Northern Ireland).

The vast majority of our products are DFARS compliant, but you must check our web catalog for the current compliance status of any product in question.

Any product not specifically identified as "DFARS compliant" in our web catalog is either non-compliant or of unknown status, and therefore is not certified to be DFARS compliant.
